

INVITATION TO BID

Notice is given of the receipt of bids for the following Project: Sanitary Sewer Main Rehabilitation to include cleaning, televising and lining with CIP products approx. 3,200 LF of sewer main, lining/replacing approx. 100 sewer service laterals, install 3 manholes, repair/replace interior brick/precast manholes, and restore areas disturbed by construction.

A pre-bid meeting followed by a site visit will be held on Monday, April 19, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the Municipal Building at the address shown above. Attendance at the meeting is **mandatory**. Bids from parties not present at the meeting and site visit will not be accepted.

Bidding Documents may be examined without charge at the office of the Engineer at the address shown above. Copies of Bidding Documents may be obtained at the office of the Engineer for a non-refundable fee of \$110.00 per set plus postage and handling.

It is a requirement of the Contract that at least 50% of the Work required by this Project be performed by Bidder.

The Contract will be subject to the prevailing minimum wage determination established by the Department of Labor and Industry of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Each Bid must be accompanied by Bid security in the form of a certified check, bank check, or Bid bond (in the required form) for 10 percent of the Bid total.

The BOROUGH hereby reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any omissions, errors, or irregularities not involving price, time, or change in the Work, in any Bid. Further, the Borough reserves the right to award any combination of base bid and alternates, which it, in its sole discretion, determines to be in its best interest.
