



Recycle Today To Save Tomorrow!



Here's how you can help:



1. Place your recycling bin out for collection on your scheduled pick up day.
2. When placing paper products in recycling bins with other recyclables, be sure paper is covered by heavier material so it doesn't blow away!
3. Bundle any large loose pieces of cardboard that will not fit in your recycling bin.
4. Check out the guidelines below to learn how to recycle successfully.

Containers



Recycle These Items:

Plastics

#1 - #7 containers & bottles with necks smaller than their bases

Glass

Clear, brown, & green glass food and beverage containers

Metal Cans

Aluminum beverage cans

Steel food and beverage cans

Aerosol cans

Prepare

1. Remove caps/lids.
2. Rinse thoroughly.
3. It is okay to leave on labels & neck rings

UNACCEPTABLE:

- NEEDLES (Do NOT place used needles with recycling! This is a serious health hazard for everyone.)
- Plastic tubs, cups, & trays
- Broken glass
- Windows, mirrors, ceramics
- Drinking glasses
- Aluminum foil
- Scrap metal
- Tupperware or disposable plastic containers
- Plastic tableware, (knives, forks, spoons, etc)
- Plastic grocery bags
- Light bulbs
- All solvent, oil & chemical containers

Paper, Paperboard & Cardboard

Recycle These Items:

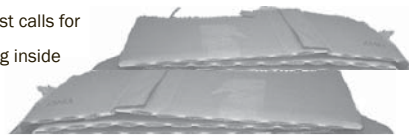
- Cardboard boxes
- Pizza boxes
- Food boxes (i.e. cereal & jello boxes)
- Empty Paper towel & toilet paper rolls
- Paperboard packaging (i.e. tissue boxes)
- Office paper (any color)
- Shredded paper (in clear plastic bags please)
- Newspapers & inserts
- Magazines, catalogs, & brochures
- Junk mail & envelopes
- Paper bags
- Phone books & other soft cover books

Prepare:

1. Remove all packaging (styrofoam, peanuts, plastic, bubble wrap, plastic liners, etc.)
2. Flatten ALL boxes.
3. Bundle cardboard that does not fit into the recycling bin.
4. Cover loose paper with heavier containers to prevent it from blowing away.
5. Check weather forecast: If the forecast calls for high winds or rain, keep your recycling inside until the following week if possible.

UNACCEPTABLE:

- Plastic bags
- Food soiled material
- Paperboard Juice Containers
- Soaked and/or wet papers or cardboard
- Plastic food wrappers
- Used paper towels or tissues

BULK ITEM GUIDELINES

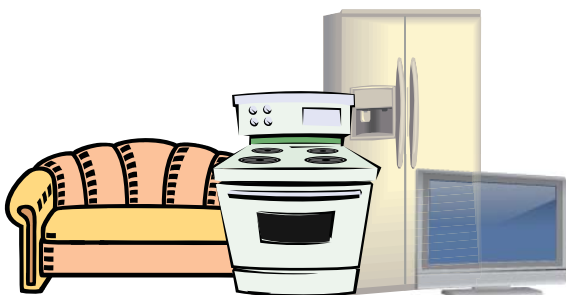
Spring Grove Borough residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curbside collection on your Friday collection day only. Please have your waste, recycling, and bulk item available for collection at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Friday morning.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS - appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, television sets, lawnmowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, also three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied) equals one bulk item.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS - chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete)

Additional Instructions - No items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Appliances with Freon - will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. (Items include but not limited to: air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc)

Regular Trash Removal



Delayed Trash Removal Due to Holiday

Collection days that fall on or after the holidays noted in **RED** will be delayed one day.

Exception: There is no change in service prior to or after a holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

BASIC GUIDELINES FOR SPRING GROVE BOROUGH RESIDENTS

- Trash, Recycling and bulk item pick-up day is FRIDAY (see calendar above for months with service 2x/week)
- Trash, Recycling and ONE (1) bulk item must be curbside by 7:00 am
- No more than FOUR (4) bags or cans may be placed at the curb for pick-up
- Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds
- Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing freon (i.e. air conditioners and refrigerators)
- No construction debris is collected curbside
